



Hemoglobin Checkup & Anemia Detection Camp

Department of M.Pharm conducted a Hemoglobin checkup & anemia detection camp at Jigisha Hospital, Satara in association with YSPM's, Yashoda Technical Campus, Satara on 23rd Oct 2018. Anemia is a wide spreading condition in our society due to various reasons like nutritional deficiency, socio-economic and demographic factors. The recent survey have shown that in India approx 50% girls are suffering from this condition whereas the ratio of the anemia suffering in boys falls around 30%. A contingent of 09 Team Members comprising of Prof. Omkar Devade and PG students of M.Pharm contributed effectively to estimate the hemoglobin and advised them for proper diet, medication wherever required under the guidance of Dr (Mrs). S. M. Bute from Jigisha Hospital, Satara. Addressing the occasion, Dr (Mrs). S. M. Bute said, "One way to prevent iron deficiency anemia is to increase iron intake through diet. You can get iron from a variety of foods especially leafy green vegetables". The chief reason of anemia among girls is to skip proper diet for reducing body weight amongst others. Prof. Omkar Devade counseled the young girls for their health & intellect perspectives with nutrition and life style and given them certain tips to prevent anemia." Prof. V. K. 

Also Students activity Online Quiz competition was planned by AICTE guideline and CESA club.




Report on YOGA for Students






